We regret that he has had such hard luck, because he is a trusty man and a hard worker. He has been working against an obstacle all season, having broken three ribs last fall.

Bible and "Tubby" Graves, and with the experience of the last four games, our men have rapidly developed into a fighting team that has caused every other team to look toward it in admiration. Our future looks promising, and with the same fighting spirit that is being displayed, they should produce a brand of football in
