Thorp contacted Texas Governor Hogg, who cleared the cowboy of blame so that he could take back his real name and marry his


The man, said Thorp, was James Dahlman, who was later to nomnate William Jennings Bryan for the presidency and who served as mayor of Omaha longer than any other man.
