Commons to begin serving Duncan's weekend meals

A joint decision by the Corps of Cadets staff and the Food Services Department to close Duncan Dining Hall on weekends could save up to \$6,000 a month, according to P.K. Imbrie, Corps supply officer.

Imbrie said the services of Duncan and the Commons would be combined because not enough students were eating at either place to justify expenses. The combination will continue on a trial basis for the rest of the semester.

Lloyd Smith, assistant director of Food Services said a large part of the savings could be attributed to the combining of labor forces at Duncan and the Commons.

"We are a bit short-handed right now, and this would allow us to combine the labor forces instead of hiring a lot of new help," Smith said.

Corps members will be required to wear uniforms to meals in the Commons, Imbrie said.

"The commutation fees we get

from the armed services are based on our being a seven-day Corps," he said. Most Corps members only wear uniforms on weekends when they eat, he added.

"So, if we were to not wear uniforms to eat, we could have to forfeit

two days of money — we'd be considered a five-day Corps," he explained.

At all other times, Corps members will not be required to wear uniforms when they visit the Commons.

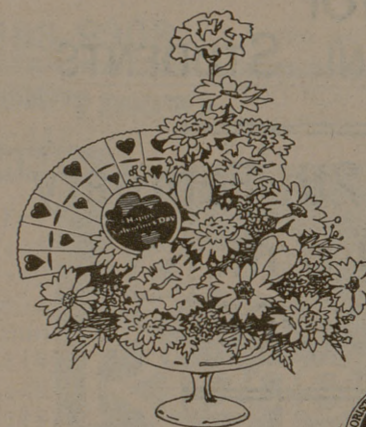

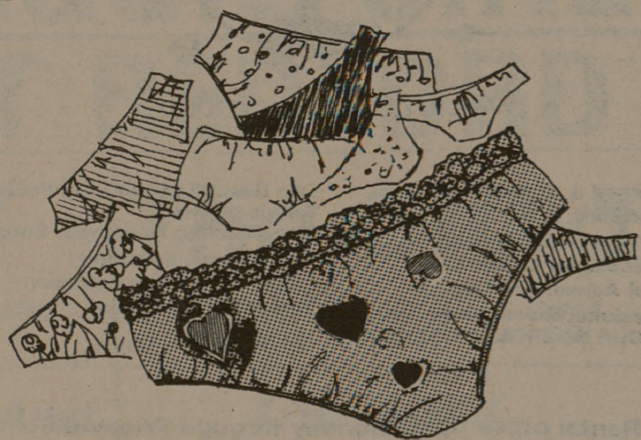
