# Creation theories subject of federal court battle

**LITTLE ROCK** — The San Diego based Creation Science Research Center wants to assist Attorney General Steve Clark, who has the task of defending Arkansas' unique "creation-science" law, now challenged in federal court.

The American Civil Liberties Union filed suit in federal court claiming the law violates the constitutionally guaranteed separation of church and state.

The San Diego center fought a similar battle in California courts several months ago, and sharing its information with Arkansas could save state attorneys "years of research," said Nell Segraves in a telephone interview.

Her son, Kelly Segraves, directs the San Diego center. He and his teen-age son, Kasey, filed a suit in California — billed as a modern-day Scopes Monkey Trial — to challenge the teaching of evolution as hostile to religious beliefs.

A California judge ruled schools must observe a 1973 policy requiring evolution be taught as theory rather than fact. The ruling left both fundamentalist Christians and the California Board of Education claiming victory.

"Our case was three years in the development," Mrs. Segraves

said. The center's attorney, Richard Turner of Sacramento, will offer his help to the Arkansas attorney general's office in fighting the ACLU suit filed last week, she said.

The ACLU was joined by religious leaders including the Catholic and Methodist bishops in Arkansas as plaintiffs in the suit. The new law requires the biblical account of creation be discussed whenever evolution is discussed in public schools, although religion is not to be mentioned.

"I don't see how they have a ghost of a chance challenging this particular bill," Mrs. Segraves said. "It is thoroughly philosophical oriented toward policy under the constitution. If they're going to nullify the constitution and the Bill of Rights as it protects religious beliefs, I don't think they've got a leg to stand on in court."

The Arkansas law is better than most, Mrs. Segraves said, because it does not mandate the teaching of evolution or creation-science.

"You can have an excellent science program without ever having to refer to origins ever," she said.

Mrs. Segraves said she is not necessarily in favor of balanced treatment for creation-science and evolution — a popular perception of the desires of fundamentalist Christians.

"I don't want evolution frozen in concrete in equal time with creation. I feel if the evidence for both positions is known to the stu-

dent, one will automatically overwhelm the other. That would be done through logic, reason, persuasion," she said.

Evolution may eventually be entirely disproved by further scientific study, she said. Teaching alongside creation science recognizes "they are philosophical belief systems from two different perspectives."

If left standing, the new law goes into effect in the fall in 1982, the state Education Department may be casting about for creation science books and materials. San Diego center — not affiliated with the Creation Science Research Institute in El Cajon, Calif., Mrs. Segraves noted — already sent a boxload of material to Sherman Peterson, who sees textbooks for the Arkansas Education Department.

But Mrs. Segraves was offended at the suggestion they were solicited. She said she telephoned Peterson to offer the center's aid and "his response was to appreciate hearing from me."

Peterson said Monday Mrs. Segraves "would be happy to look them over." Her decision has been reached, she said, the textbooks because the education department recommends science textbooks in 1979 and not review science books until 1984 unless a school district makes a special request.

Peterson told UPI last week that Mrs. Segraves indicated she would sell some of her material. But Mrs. Segraves said Monday the center is a nonprofit service organization and is satisfied with Arkansas law regardless of whether the center makes a sale.

"They don't have to buy creation-science materials to buy their curriculum," Mrs. Segraves said. "They need to buy textbooks that don't give offense to religious beliefs."

Among the books sent to Peterson is "The Handy Dandy Evolution Refuter." It is not a textbook, Mrs. Segraves said, but was sent for "students facing a hostile environment with evolution oriented textbooks."

It has some scriptural references, but Mrs. Segraves said you can reference Darwin, can reference scripture.
