Suit filed against USDA to force state quarantine

AUSTIN — Agriculture Commissioner Reagan Brown said Tuesday he is filing suit against the

U.S. Department of Agriculture to force the department to quarantine the entire state of California and require that all produce shipped out of the state be fumigated to control the Mediterranean fruit fly.

Brown was sharply critical of the USDA's efforts to control the Medfly in California, and said he will use the authority given him by the Legislature last week to require that all produce originating in quarantined counties of California be fumigated before it is allowed in Texas. This would be effective Sunday.

The federal court suit, filed in Dallas, will ask the U.S. to reimburse the state for the cost of such fumigations and the maintenance of inspection stations on highways connecting Texas with California. It also seeks to force the USDA and California produce associations from interfering with Texas' plan to protect its produce from the fruit fly.

"The United States Department of Agriculture has been negligent, they have been slow, they have been behind the spread of the fruit fly in California," Brown said.

"It is obvious now that they do not know where the Mediterranean fruit fly is, and they (the flies) are spreading every day."

The commissioner also cited some harsh criticism for California Gov. Edmund G. Brown Jr. over his handling of the campaign against the fly which has cost millions of dollars in damage to California fruit and vegetable crops.

"Jerry Brown has demonstrated every time he's discussed fumigation," the Texas commissioner said. "He says it's dangerous, and that same government required us to fumigate our produce going to California for a number of years. He has endorsed it yet he has the audacity to say we don't want to fumigate because it's dangerous. It's not dangerous."

Brown said Texas Department of Agriculture inspectors have been cutting and checking fruit for the Medfly larvae after it arrived in Texas destination, but beginning Sunday will check the produce as it enters the state.

"We're going to start cutting the highways, and it's about a hundred degrees out there. So what are we asking California to do is fumigate all the materials that are bound for the Medfly coming out of California."
