



## SG run-off candidates to be at symposium

Student body presidential candidates Mike Cook and Sean Royall will be the speakers at Sully's Symposium Tuesday at 12:15 p.m. in front of the Lawrence Sullivan Ross statue.

Cook and Royall will face each other in the run-off election for student body president Wednesday.

In the regular election last week, Royall received the largest percentage of the vote, with 30.4 percent of all votes cast, followed by Cook with 22.5 percent.

The symposium, sponsored by Lambda Sigma, is usually held Wednesday at noon but was rescheduled this week because the group wanted to have the symposium before the run-off election.

"Students need to know their president," said Amy Lovett, a member of both Lambda Sigma and the Student Government election commission. "They need to get to know who they're voting for."

During the symposium, both candidates will have five minutes for opening statements and then will be asked three questions. The questions will be selected by Lambda Sigma and the Student Government election commission.

After the prepared questions, audience members will be able to ask questions. Both candidates then will present their closing statements.

Lambda Sigma President Cindy Gay said, "We really hope this encourages voter turnout and stimulates interest in the election."


