Wife injured on birthday, sues husband for \$6 million

AUSTIN (AP) — A woman se-verely injured in a motor scooter accident during a party celebrating her 35th birthday has won a \$6 million judgment against her husband. The lawsuit was brought against Lee Lane, an Austin radio personal-gany, but that also is not



Once inside, the thieves thoroughly searched each room and then stole most things of value through a back door. Police estimate the loss to be more than \$9,000.




