

# McCaskill shuts down Rangers in 4-3 win

## The White Sox have won eight of their last 10

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — Kirk McCaskill picked up his first victory of the spring, allowing three hits over two innings as the Chicago White Sox edged the Texas Rangers 4-3 Thursday.

McCaskill hadn't pitched since March 20 when he gave up two runs and four hits in four innings against New York. But he allowed only an unearned run in the first against Texas for his first victory in five appearances.
