Shore to perform at the Loose Moose

The Loose Moose will be serving up a dose of the Weasel tonight in College Station as Pauly Shore kicks off his stand-up comedy tour of Texas with an appearance in Aggieland.

Shore said he is on tour for many reasons but ultimately to make people laugh. He also wants a chance to let his audience and his fans know what he has been doing.

Shore recently completed a new semi-autobiographical dark comedy he wrote, starred in and directed called *You'll Never Wield In This Town Again*.

"It should be out in about six months," Shore said. Shore said he worked extremely hard to make the film special because he has not released anything recently. The film has an impressive cast with more than 40 cameo appearances from stars such as Whoopi Goldberg, Sean Penn, Chris Rock and Ben Stiller. Shore said he especially enjoyed working with Verne Troyer. Troyer is known as "Mini-Me" in the film *Austin Powers: The Spy Who Shagged Me*.

Shore gained popularity after his 1990 debut on MTV with his show "Totally Pauly" and has remained a spring break icon on the network. He went on to work on film projects such as *Encino Man*, *Son-In-Law* and *In the Army Now*.

In addition to TV and starring in feature films, Shore has released a series of comedy albums, including his fourth release, *Pauly Shore: Hollywood We Have a Problem*.

Shore said it has been a while since he has been in Texas, and he is excited to return. Shore also

said he appreciates the love he receives from Texas fans. "I love Texas," Shore said. "People like to have Texas."

Shore said he always wanted to be a comedian. His parents' love of comedy made an impression early in his life.

"I absorbed what my dad and ran with it," Shore said. "I am just a comic. I am make people laugh."

Shore said each of his performances is different. He gears his material toward the people he sees in the crowd.

"Every audience is different so you have to adapt to a particular audience," Shore said. "I wait until I get a laugh and then I mix it up."

Shore said he loves performing but it has a negative side. He said traveling presents the largest obstacle in his life.

Shore said, however, the positive aspects of his far outweigh the negative. He said when he takes the stage he is able to remember what he wants to be a comedian.

"I enjoy being on stage and see all the faces laugh," Shore said. "It is a high that can't explain."

Shore said some of his audience members might find his material offensive because of its graphic nature. "If you get offended by material you should come," Shore said.

Shore said he is expected to have an excellent time at Loose Moose.

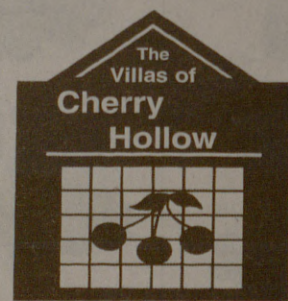
"The most brilliant man to ever hit College Station is coming your way," Shore said.
