ized of 255.

"Under existing law, officers of the Marine Corps may be appointed from the following sources: (1) Graduates of the Naval Academy; (2) Meritorious non-commissioned officers of the Marine Corps; (3) Civil life.

"A number of appointments from these sources have been made since the passage of the above-mentioned bill, but there are still remaining a large number of vacancies to be filled. Major General George Barnett, Commandant of the Marine Corps, is extremely desirous of filling a large proportion of these vacancies by the appointment of grad-

uates of the military colleges designated by the War Department as "Distinguished Colleges" and on his recommendation the Secretary of the Navy has authorized the appointment as second lieutenants of sixty of this year's graduates of these colleges.
