Mail posted by 11:30 a. m. will reach the northbound 1:28 H. & T. C. or any other train during the day.

Mail posted by 2:30 p. m. will reach the southbound 3:45 I. & G. N. or the 4:25 southbound H. & T. C.

Mail posted before 2:30 p. m. will go north or south on the night trains of the same day.

Southbound mail posted between 2:30 and 5:00 p. m. will go south that same night.

Northbound mail posted after 2:30 p. m. does not go north until the next day.
