

Fraternity will undoubtedly become, with a membership distributed over so vast a territory, renders it imperative that there shall be a small executive body invested with plenary powers and authorized to act in all ordinary matters for the Fraternity. Such shall be the duties of the Campus Council. It shall be composed of the commander, vice commander and officer of the day. The Campus shall be empowered to suspend the commander or any officer for cause, to temporarily suspend any by-law, to order votes of the Fraternity by letter on such subjects as they think demand such action. They may expend in the interest of the Fraternity any available funds not exceeding 75 per cent. of the annual collections, reporting same fully to the next annual meeting. They shall constitute a committee on secret ceremonies and may revise same, except password and grips, when they deem it necessary, and, in short, shall be the authorized representatives of the Fraternity at large while it is not in session. They shall make a report to the Fraternity of all their actions, any of which actions may be set aside by a two-thirds vote of the Fraternity.

All commanders on retiring from office shall become members of the Campus Council and entitled to all the privileges thereof. They shall then bear the title of past commander.

SECTION V.

Art. 1. Each member of the Fraternity shall be entitled to one vote at the meetings, but must cast the vote himself. No proxies shall be allowed.

Art. 2. The Campus council may order a vote by let-
