Tulane. Tulane five yards. Tulane two yards. Tulane one yard. Tulane kicks to McArthur, who advances five yards. End first half. A. and M.'s ball on forty-second-yard line.

Third Quarter.

Bateman in for McArthur, Bell for Beasley, Higginbotham for Vesmirovsky. Tulane kicks to Bell, who advances twenty-five yards. Bateman loses two yards. Higginbotham ten yards. Bell seven yards. Bell five yards through tackle. Bateman five yards. Crow two yards through left tackle. Kern five yards. Bell five yards. Bell seven yards through tackle. Bell two yards. Bateman two yards. Higginbotham three yards. Bateman loses one yard. Monte makes twenty-two yards on pass from Bateman. Ball within two yards of goal. Bateman carries it over for touchdown. Higginbotham misses goal. A. and M. 27; Tulane 0.

Higginbotham kicks to Tulane's goal line, ball is advanced nineteen yards. Tulane four yards. Tulane two yards in two attempts. Tulane kicks to Bateman, who is held. Bateman on pass to Kern nets fifteen yards. Pass to Higginbotham fails. Higginbotham on straight line buck goes thirty-five yards for touchdown. Higginbotham kicks goal. A. and M. 34; Tulane 0.

Higginbotham kicks to Tulane on five-yard line, who advances twenty yards. Tulane loses one yard. Tulane gains three yards. Tulane four yards through center. Tulane kicks to Bell, who advances eleven yards. Kern nets eight yards on fake end run. Higginbotham six yards on line buck. End third quarter. A. and M.'s ball on Tulane's thirty-second-yard line.

Fourth Quarter.

Beasley for Bateman, Vesmirovsky for Higginbotham, McArthur for Bell. Everett twenty yards on end run. Crow two yards through tackle. Beasley three yards. Beasley loses one yard. Kern fails to gain. Tulane's ball. Tulane four yards. Tulane fails to gain. Tulane three yards. Tulane kicks to Kern, who signals for fair catch. Vesmirovsky tries field goal and misses by small margin. Tulane's ball on twenty-yard line. Tulane tries pass, McArthur catching. A. and M.'s ball. Vesmirovsky no gain on straight line buck. Vesmirovsky eight yards on line buck. Montgomery receives pass from McArthur and carries ball thirty-five yards to within one yard of goal line. A. and M. tries three times to carry ball over, but could not gain an inch. On fourth trial Beasley makes pas sto Montgomery over goal line for touchdown. Vesmirovsky kicks goal. A. and M. 41; Tulane 0.

Kendrick in for Montgomery. Vesmirovsky kicks to Tulane, who advances ten yards. Tulane in two attempts fails to gain. Tulane three yards around end. Tulane kicks to

McArthur, no advance. McArthur loses yard. Pass from McArthur to Everett fails. Vesmirovsky drops back and kicks the ball seventy yards, the longest punt this season. The ball goes way over Tulane's goal line. Ball brought out and put in play on Tulane's twenty-yard line. Tulane on two attempts loses two yards. Tulane on pass nets fourteen yards. Tulane kicks to McArthur, who does not advance. Everett on end run gains thirty-five yards. End of game. Final score: A. and M. 41; Tulane 0.
