

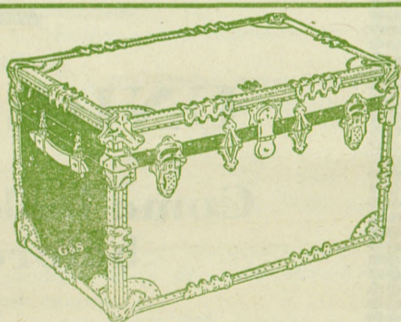
**THE COLLEGE BUREAU ISSUES ILLUSTRATIVE BOOKLET DESCRIBING THE CONDITIONS HERE.**
