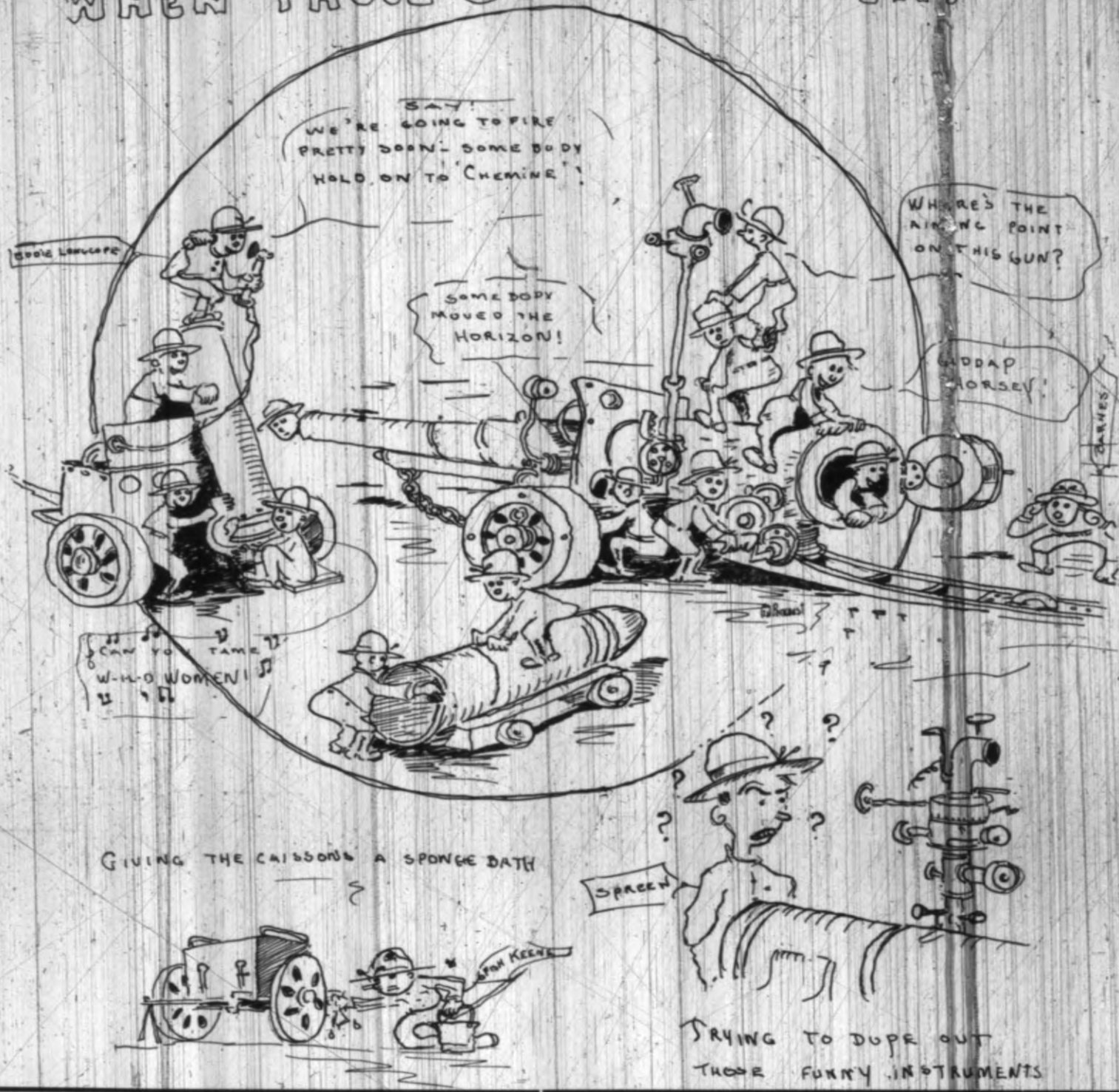


WHEN THOSE GUNS COME IN?



WALTER E. JENKINS.

Born July 8th, 1893, at El Paso, Texas. Attended public schools in El Paso, was graduated from El Paso Military Institute, Fort Bliss, Texas, June, 1911. Attended Tulane University of Louisiana, New Orleans, La. Member Phi Delta Theta fraternity. Enlisted Company K 4th Infantry Texas National Guard July 12, 1908. Honorably discharged as Battalion Sergeant Major, July 11, 1911. Appointed Second Lieutenant of Infantry, Texas National Guard, assigned 4th Infantry, T. N. G., assigned Co. K. Battalion Quartermaster and Commissary, February 20, 1914. Promoted First Lieutenant, March 20, 1915, assigned 4th Infantry T. N. G. as Battalion Adjutant. Promoted Captain July 15, 1915, assigned to 4th Infantry T. N. G., commanded Company K. Answered call by the president May 9, '16, mustered into Federal service May 17, 1916, Fort Sam Houston, Texas. Ordered to the Company stationed at Terlingua, May 27, 1916, and La Jitas. Ordered to Fort Sam Houston, Texas, February 11, 1917. Ordered to El Paso, Texas, March 24th, 1917. Ordered to Elephant Butt, New Mexico, March 31, 1917. Ordered to

Fort Brown, Texas, June 5th, 1917. Attended School of Trench Warfare, Fort Brown from July 20th, to August 27, 1917. Ordered to Camp Bowie, Texas, to join 86th Division, October 15th, 1917. Adjutant 61st Depot Brigade, December 26, 1917 to January 31, 1918. Assigned to 305th Cavalry at Camp Stanley, Texas, January 5th, 1918. 305th Cavalry changed into 44th Field Artillery, August, 1918. Ordered to School of Fire for Field Artillery, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, October 19th, 1918, was graduated March 14t '19. Assigned to Texas A. and M. College March 28th, 1919.

WILLIS G. DUNKUM.

Born October 16th, 1890, at Marlin, Texas. Graduated Marlin High school 1908. Attended the University of Texas 3 years from 1908 thru 1911. Entered first Officers' Training Camp, Leon Springs, Texas, May 8th, 1917. Graduated August 15th, 1917 with rank of First Lieutenant. Assigned to Battery F. 345th Field Artillery, Camp Travis, Texas, reporting September 1st, 1917. Attended Ordnance Motor Schools at Four Wheel Drive Truck Factory, Clintonville, Wisconsin from January

15th until February 15th, 1918. Attended Ordnance Motor Schools at the Holt Caterpillar Tractor Factory, Peoria, Ill., from January 17th until February 28th, 1918. Reported back to 345th F. A. upon completion of schools. Transferred to Camp Jackson, S. C., May 1st, 1918. Assigned to Battery C. 1st Bn., 3rd Regt. F. A. R. D. Transferred to 9th Regt. F. A. R. D., commanding Battery C of that organization. Took command

of 2nd Battalion F. A., August 15th, 1918. Transferred to 85th F. A., Camp Sheridan, Alabama, commanding the Provisional Battery and the 1st Battalion of that organization until it was demobilized, December 19, 1918. Detailed to attend the School of Fire, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, reported January 5th, 1919. Graduated School of Fire, March 14th, 1919. Assigned to Texas A. and M. College March 28, 1919.
