Lewis drove in a run in the first inning and two more in the third. In the fifth Higginbotham and Forrest executed a double steal, Hig scoring. In the eighth Forrest took one in the ribs, was sacrificed to second by Rothe, took third on Touchstone's infield out, and scored on Smith's single.

The Aggies were especially elated over their four straight over the Bears, as the latter said that after their series here they felt on even terms, as the umpire took the first game from them. The umpire didn't succeed in taking either game at Waco from the Aggies.
