

## BEST ATHLETIC FIELD IN SOUTH NOW AT A. & M.

8,000 Excellent Seats Will be Available This Year; New Grandstand on Football Field.

When the Aggie football candidates report to Kyle field Sept. 10 to begin the training season they will find that field in wonderful condition. Business Manager James Sullivan has left no stone unturned these hot summer days to put the park in the best possible shape. The completion of the new steel bleachers on the west side of the field, filling and resodding of the playing field, repairs to dressing rooms are three of the many things which have been done this summer to improve the appearance of the park and to make it more convenient for players and spectators alike.

The Texas Aggies now have the best organized athletic park in the South. The provision of a new playing court for basketball and a field dressing station, which it is hoped can be done within the next year or so, will make the park and its equipment ideal.

There will be 8,000 most excellent seats available constantly at the football park at Kyle field.

The new steel grandstand is the same type as the old one, the only difference being in size. The old one extends the full length of the gridiron, 360 feet, while the new one will only touch the 15 yard line at each end, being 200 feet in length. Its capacity inclusive of box seats will be 3,500. The capacity of the old one is 6,200.
