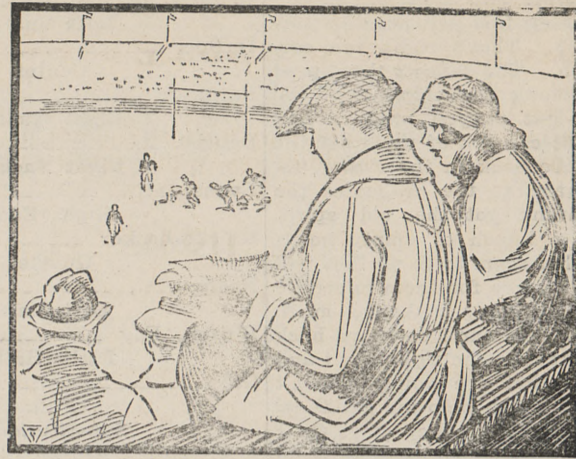
"LITTLE JOHNNY JONES"

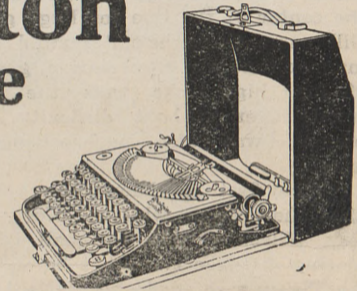
