Yet to the self-same ends contrives.

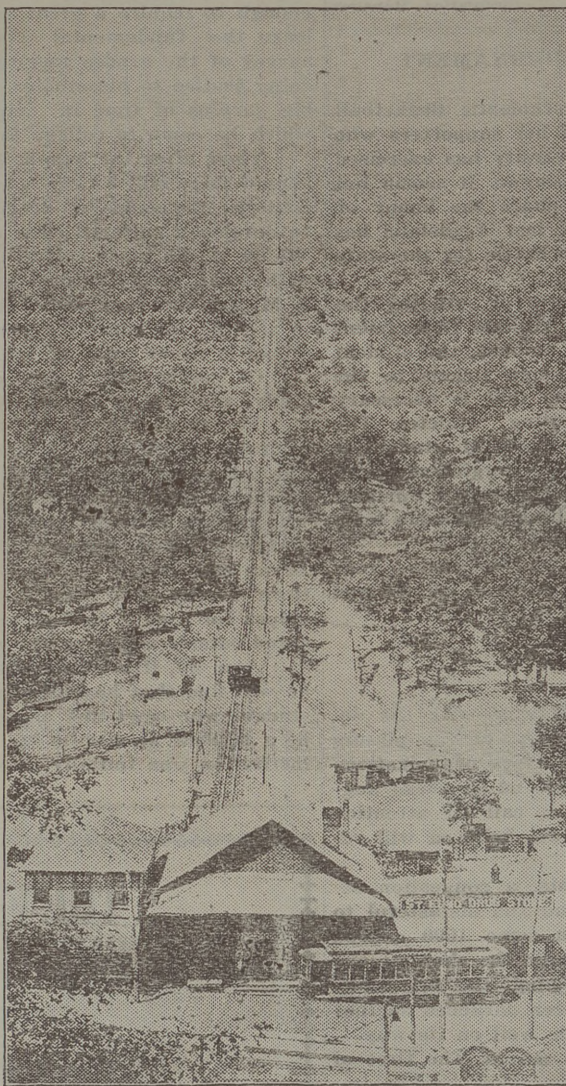
