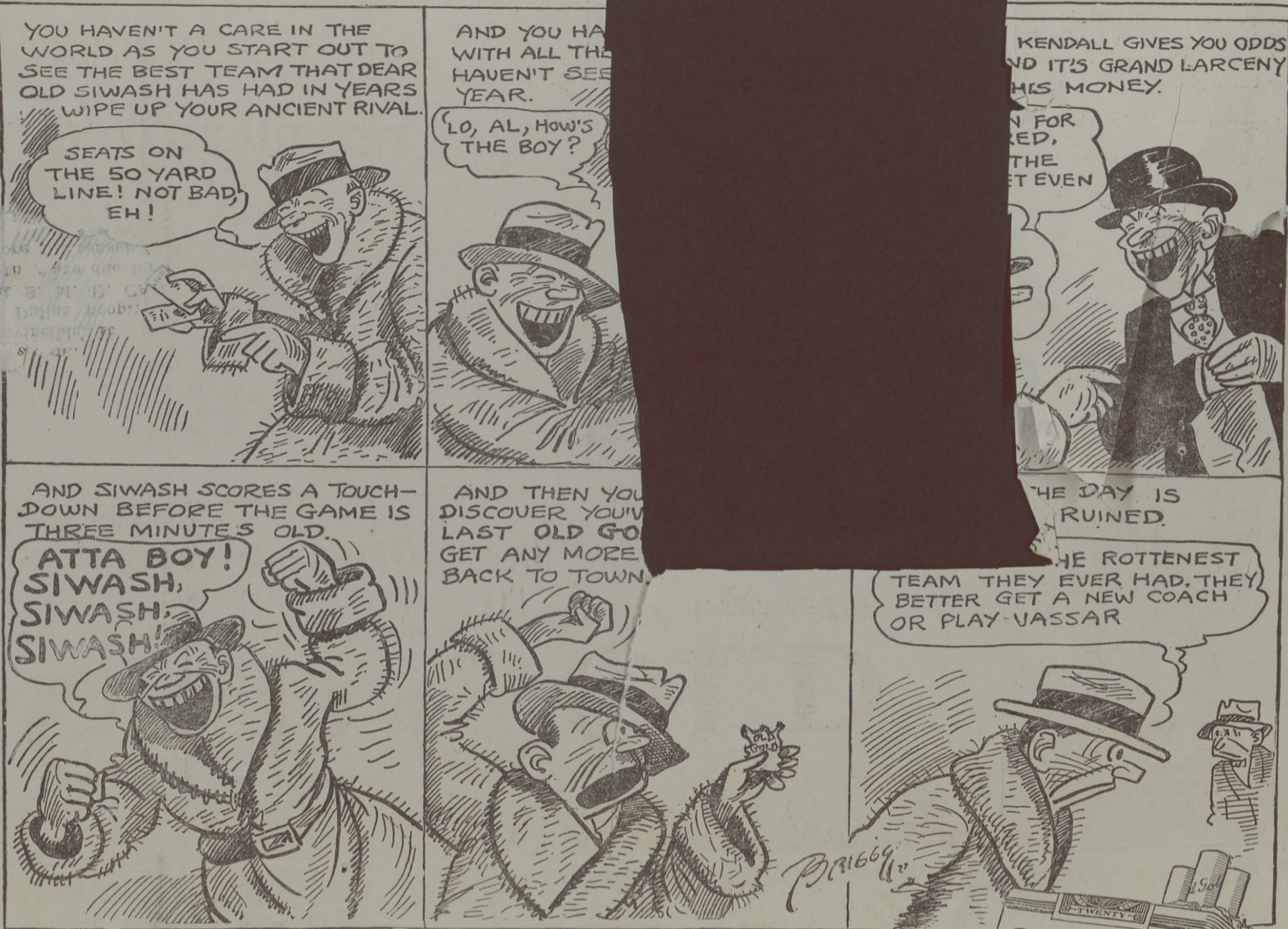

ORGANIZATION PARTICIPATION POINT SYSTEM

- Major Sports
- Basketball
 - Football
 - Speedball
 - Playground Ball
 - Horseshoe
 - Pitching
 - Track
 - Volleyball
 - Cross-Country
 - Swimming

50 points awarded for entry of a team but organization must play all its games to receive 50 points.

10 points deducted from 50 for each game forfeited.

- League winner awarded 10 points.
- League Runner-up awarded 6 pts.
- College champion awarded 10 points
- Runner-up awarded 5 points.

In Track, Swimming and Cross-Country, 50 points awarded organization if they have men entered in half of the events. Men must participate.

Winner receives 20 points with 15, 10, 5 and 1 points given for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th places respectively.
