P. E. PROGRAM INTERESTING

During the past few years, many changes have taken place in our Physical Education department, particularly in the freshmen classes. It seems that nearly everything has been improved, the courses having been changed as well as the facilities for accommodating more men. No longer do the freshmen have to dress for their classes in the stands of the gym or in their rooms as in the days of old, for now each student has access to a private locker, this alone being a great improvement over the former conditions. No longer do the freshmen have to attend their following classes in sweaty clothes, now sufficient time is allowed for the men to take a shower before the hour is past. Under the present system, the classes do not have to learn boresome folk dances on account of having nothing better to do. The men of the class of '30 can well remember that this was what happened in their case. Now, instead of dreading their Physical Education classes, as a great number of men did before the above changes were made, this freshmen class can look forward to an interesting course offered under convenient circumstances from which they will derive several benefits.

Approximately 900 men will start their work this week under the supervision of W. L. Penberthy, Director of Physical Education. This year 13 students taking courses in the Physical Education Department will assist the regular staff as student

instructors. Having studied and worked in Mr. Penberthy's classes for the past two years, these men will be capable instructors and incidentally will receive valuable training which will train them for future high school Physical Education instructors. A recent state law requires that these courses be offered so these men will be fitted for these positions. The Fish have been divided into 35 classes, each class having a student instructor.

As in the past, each student will be allowed to make his own choice of one of the seven following sports: speedball, volley ball, basketball, cross-country, boxing and wrestling. At a meeting of the Faculty last

spring, it was voted to allow grade points in the required Physical Education courses, two grade points are given for an A, and one for a B. It is hoped that this plan will cause the students to take an increased interest in this vital program. Many students, as well as grown men, do not realize the importance of devoting some of their time to the development of their physical being, and when they do, they do not always go about it in the right manner.

In addition to the varsity gym, the new intramural building, containing five hand ball, one basketball and two volley ball courts, will be used to conduct part of the
