ART EXHIBIT IS PLACED IN ARCHITECTURAL LIBRARY

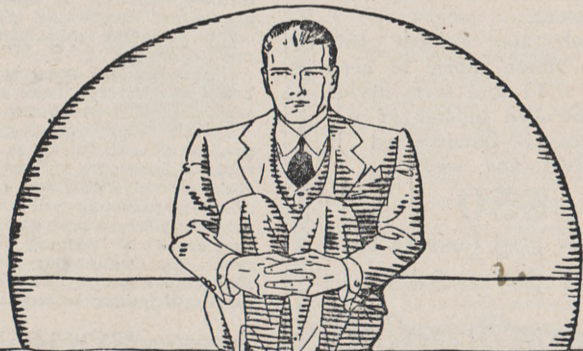
Under the auspices of the department of agriculture, work of the Parsons-New York School of Fine and Applied Art is being exhibited in the architectural library.
