The Troy pound and the apothcaries' pound each have 5,780 grains, while the avoirdupols pound has 7,000 grains. Troy weight is that which is used for clous metals. It was named for the French town of Troyes, an Important commercial center of the Fourteenth century which had its own system of weights.


