

However, eleven men have to be picked, and that's what we will do now. The champion Texas Aggies and the powerful runnerups, the Texas Longhorns each place four men, while T. C. U., S. M. U., and Rice manage for one apiece.

Ags' Derace Moser Leading the quartet of backs on the All-Conference team is the Aggies' own Derace Moser, the most consistent and the best passer in the conference.
