It may be remembered that Coach Jack Gray's star-studded quintet handed the collegiates a 62-31 lancing in their tussle at

Corpus Christi a few weeks ago. Pre-season surveys and recent basketball results indicated that Lt. Gray, along with his assistant, Ensign "Mule" Dowell, business, has certainly an A-1 team.

Headed by All-American Bob Kinney, three-time all-conference center with the Rice Owls and rated by many as the best center in collegiate basketball, and John Dick, former Oregon University cager, Corpus will roll into College Station undefeated, with three conference schools already as their victims.
