System Devised By Local Officials Is **Proving Successful**

Board of Equalization Is Meeting Now; New System Proving of Great Assistance

In order to facilitate the function of the City of College Station's Board of Equalization and in order that accuracy and impartial evaluation can be placed on taxable property within the city limits, a new form has been devised and placed in operation by the mayor and city council, it was announced this week by city officials.

The new form, which is known as a "Lot and Block Register" gives complete details concerning the property, owner, location, size, value and improvements. A feature of this new form is, that in addition to giving a complete description of the taxable property, a photograph of the property itself is attached. The form is so arranged that it may be kept up to date, bringing the assessed value forward each year.

This form, which has been recently completed on the more than five hundred pieces of taxable real estate in the city, is a step forward in municipal taxation, according to experts who have seen it in operation, and other cities are expected to follow suit and adopt this new system devised here in College Station.

Appearing with this article is a sample of the form used, having been photographed and engraved from the original now on file in the city office in the Casey-Burgess building at the south gate business district.

The form pictured herewith is the record of the property of J. Lambert Molyneaux of 115 Highlands Street, in the West Park Addition. The form was reproduced as a portion of this article with the permission of Mr. Molyneaux.
