A member of the Aggie baseball team during the spring of this year, Strickhausen was playing first base for the Aggies in a game with a Brooks Field nine in San Antonio when a mismap occurred which nearly ended his life. Midway in the sixth inning of this game, an enemy batsman knocked a grounder to the third baseman who, in making the throw to first base, threw the ball high over Strick's head. As Strickhausen leaped into the air to catch the ball, the batter, racing for first, caught him in the kidney with his shoulder, a terrific shoulder block. Although shaken up quite a bit, Strickhausen stayed in the game but later on when he was taken to the Post hospital for examination, it was discovered almost too late that he had a ruptured kidney. After the operation, he was in the hospital for two weeks, losing twenty-one pounds. Incidentally, Strickhausen won his letter in baseball and was elected team captain. Today, he still remembers and is very grateful to Coach Norton and the members of the baseball team who stuck with him and sent him flowers during his time in the hospital.
