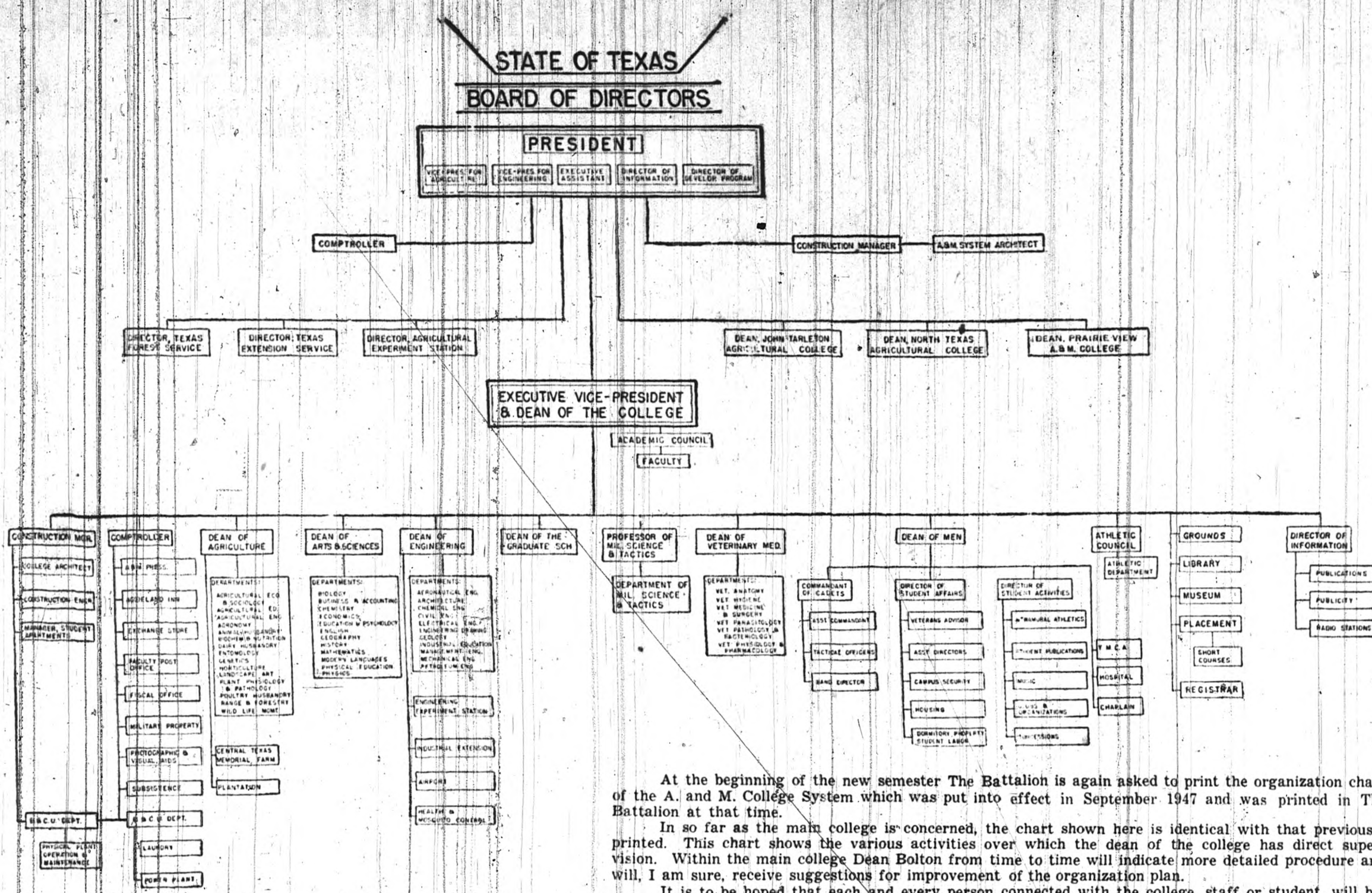


# Organization of The A&M College of Texas
