Professor M. S. Brooks, of the agricultural economics

and sociology department, in hist report, said that the goals given are: education for a fuller realization of democracy in every phase of living; education directly and explicitly for international understanding and cooperation; and education for the application of creative imagination and trained intelligence to the solution of social problems and to the administra-

tion of public affairs.

Brooks' report emphasized that the development of personal qualities "in our education for demo-cratic living cannot be left as heretofore to some courses or a few departments or extra curricula organizations. It must become a part of every phase of college life," he said.


"The curricula task of higher education today is to provide a unified general education for American youth and strike a balance between specialized training and cultural training for common citizenship.

HOW CHEAP IS \$1.80 A BOX !-

Let's put it this way. If your cousin gave you the fruit in the orchard, it would cost you \$1.08 processing-and-boxing charge, plus over \$2.00 a box express. If your own folks paid the \$1.08 cash outlay and gave you the fruit, you would lose only about 25c a box on the express. Ask them to send you the money instead. Bushel of white grapefruit, \$1.25. Bushel of mixed white grapefruit and oranges, \$1.75. In original box, 80 pounds white grapefruit, \$1.80.




