ultra-violet radiation were shown in their ordinary applications. Various mechanical and heat oddities along with high voltage and electro-magnetic stunts constituted the bulk of the other experiments performed. Booked under the heading of "Believe It Or Not In Science," these phenomena were old, but nevertheless entertaining. With a small and well-organized exhibition, the chemistry department fell short of its possibilities. Featuring glass-blowing and organic chemical processes, the show was limited to wall displays of various inorganic compounds. Of special interest was a sample of the ammonium nitrate that caused the Texas City disaster. A water softening process, perfumes, crude and refined cottonseed oil, and a model of the first steam engine rounded out the department's display. The biology department, while showing no zoological exhibits, had some excellent botanical slides and specimens. A collection of native and cultivated plants were identified to visitors by their names, the place where they were collected, and other notes of interest.

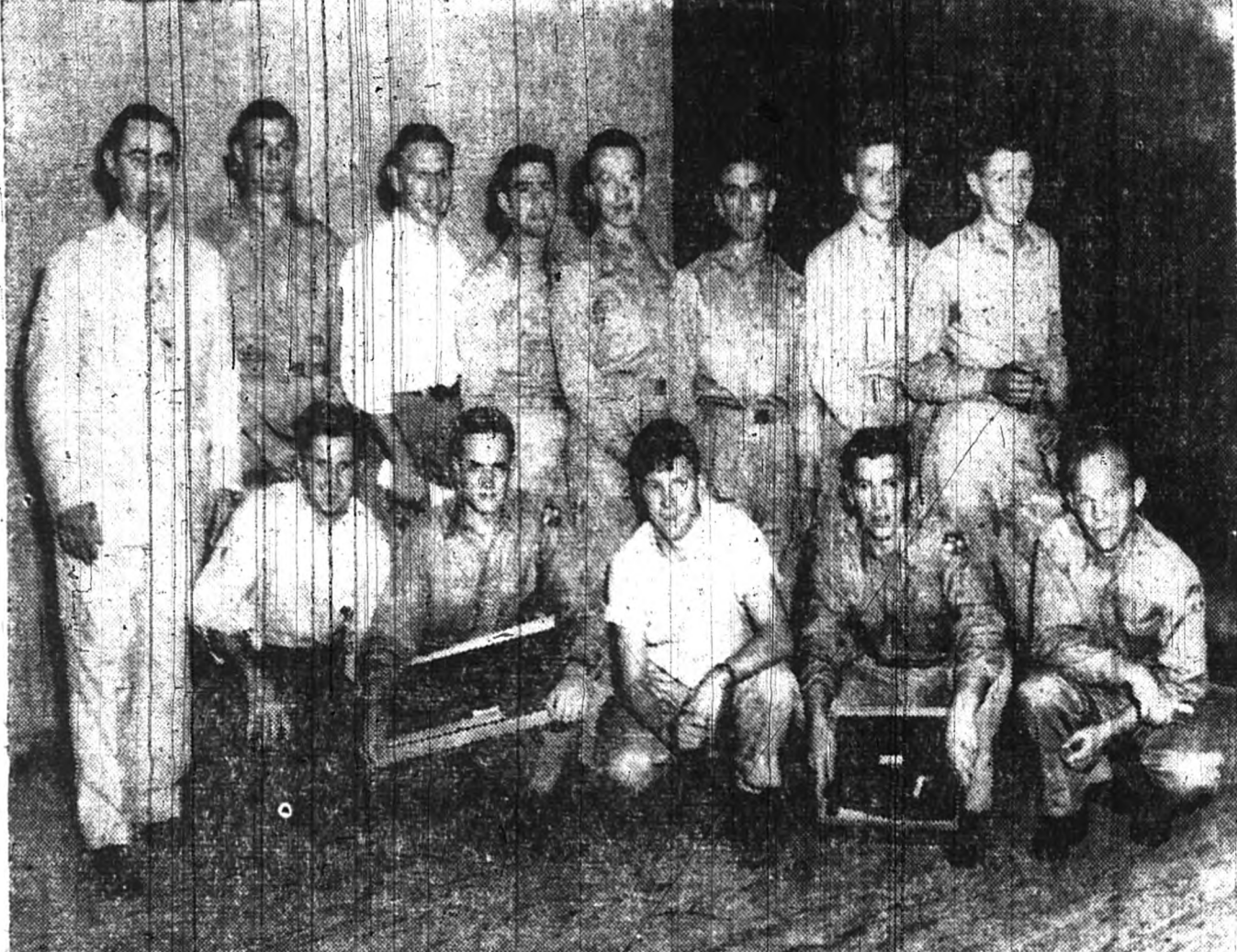

Nuclear Physics Will Be Offered In Second Term

A new course, nuclear physics, will be offered by the physics department beginning with the second summer session, J. G. Potter, head of the department, announced Friday. Potter, who will teach the course said that it will be known as Physics 312 and will deal with the elements of nuclear physics. The purpose of this course is to present the progress that enter into the atomic bomb, and the peacetime applications of atomic energy, Potter stated. The course will describe nuclear phenomena and their applications without using special mathematical methods. This course was approved by the Academic Council too late for it to be included in the summer catalog. Anyone desiring further information should see his faculty advisor or Dr. Potter.

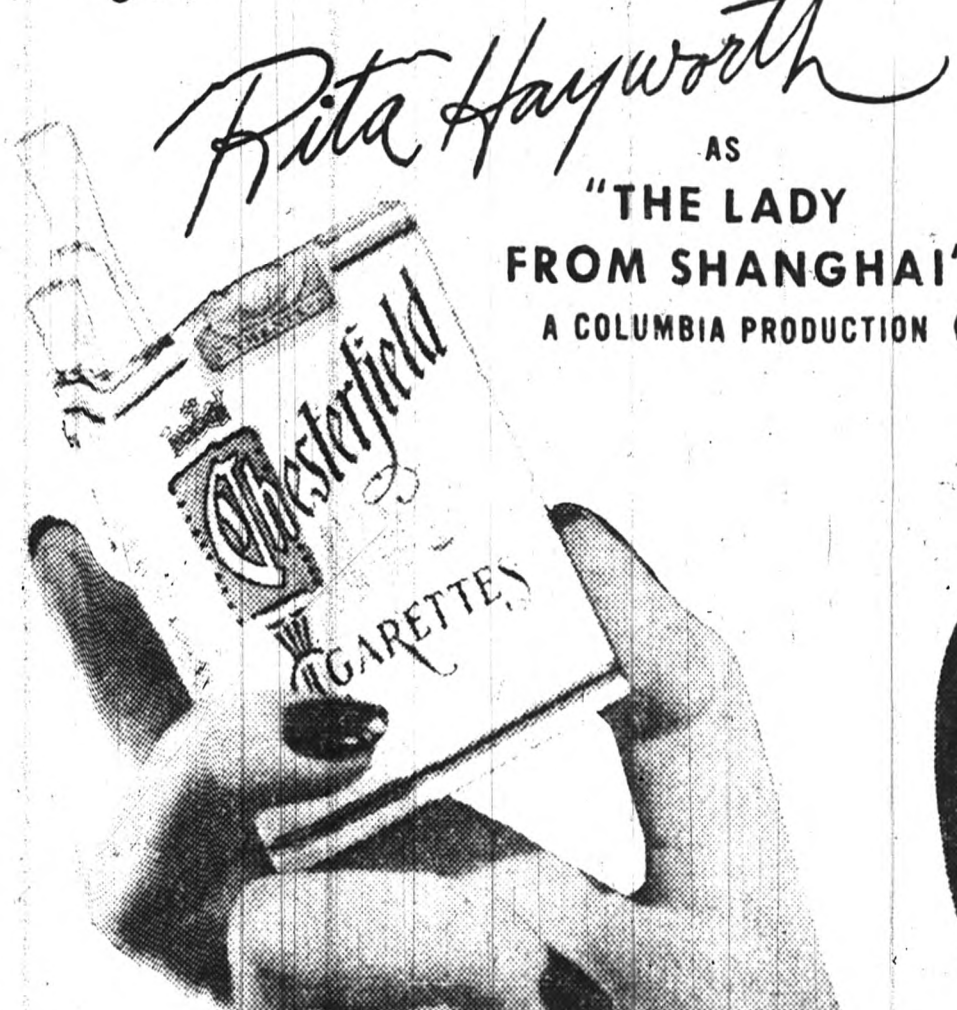
