

# Policies Affecting Students Announced by Army, Air Force

Policies affecting enrollment and continuance of stu-dents in the senior divisions of the ROTC and the Air ROTC under the provisions of the Selective Service Act of 1948 were announced jointly today by the Departments of the Army

All students falling within the

The deferment policies will apply to selected ROTC students whether they are entering their freshman year at the beginning of the 1948-49 academic term or are returning to complete their formal education.

To be eligible for deferment until the completion of their ac-demic training, students enrolled demic training, students enrolled in ROTC units must remain in good standing in both their academic and military courses, must show sufficient aptitude in leadership, and must attend a summer training camp.

In addition, they are required to sign an agreement to accept a commission in the Army or Air.






