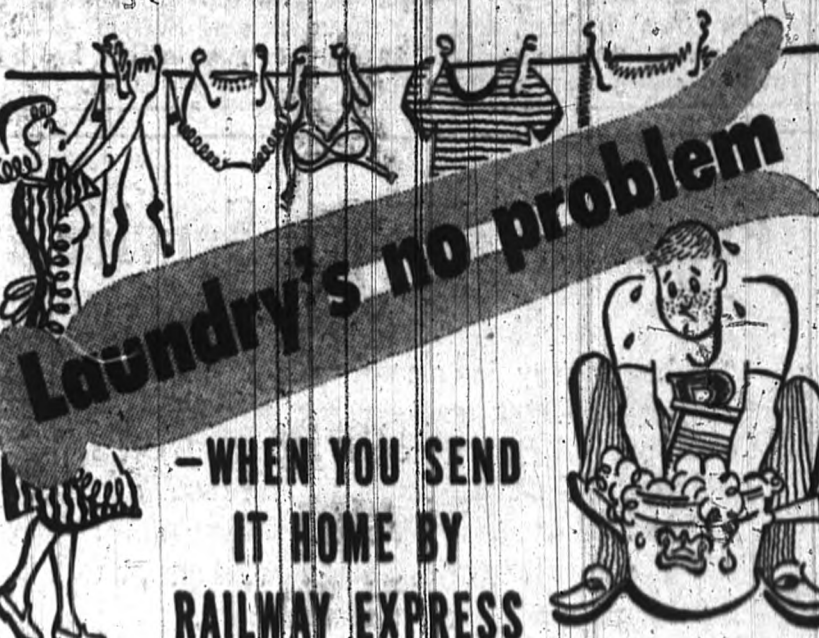

mittee which has made the overall plan for all the districts. The conference's goal is to integrate the teaching of English in Texas colleges and high schools, to the extent that when the high school graduate enters college his English work will follow smoothly and efficiently on his high school course.

"Much of the time and effort of pupils has sometimes been wasted in the past when high schools and colleges have ignored each other's methods or duplicated each other's work," Dr. Mayo said. "The best way, the joint committee thinks, to achieve better integration, is for the two groups of teachers to agree to emphasize the fundamentals in the structure and use of language."

"We all need to require much practice, carefully supervised, corrected and reworked, in writing and in reading comprehension. Above all," Dr. Mayo points out, "the two groups of English teachers need to discuss such matters frequently together and to learn from each other the aims and methods of our common task. Moreover, high school students who will not go to college will be greatly benefited by the same procedure," he says.

Two representatives, one high school and one college, from each of the 11 districts in the state, make up the joint committee.
