

Farm Youth Guests Oct. 16 At State Fair

Young Texas farmers will be guests at the State Fair of Texas October 16, J. W. Potts, 4-H Club State Agent has announced. All 4-H, FFA, and FHA members throughout the state will be invited guests.

Potts stated that about 60,000 boys and girls will attend this year as compared to 45,000 that attended last year. The entire day will be high-lighted with special events which are of interest to the various rural organizations that will be represented.

One such event is the selection of an outstanding boy and girl club member from each of the 14 extension districts in the state. The winners of this contest will receive special awards and they and their parents will be guests of the Chamber of Commerce at a banquet given in their honor.

Also scheduled on that day will be the presentation of a registered Brahman bull to an outstanding 4-H Club boy in the state. The Registered Brahman Association is sponsoring the contest.

An award, according to Potts, will be presented to the county organization that has traveled the farthest and has the most members attending. The award will be a \$100 check for the winning county.

Numerous other events and activities are scheduled for that day, specifically arranged for the entertainment of all rural youth that attends.

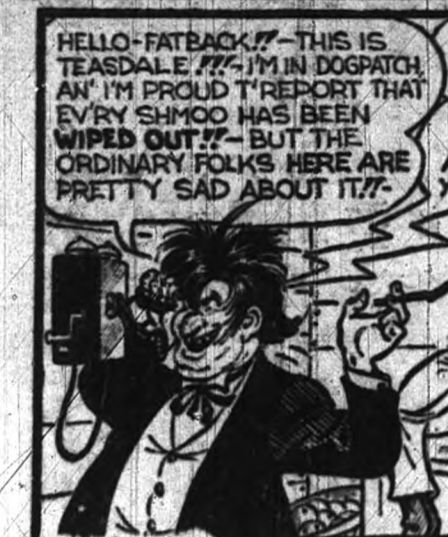
