

# Cast for 'The Little Foxes' Released by Aggie Players

Mrs. Betty Jo Edwardson of College Station has been chosen to portray the leading female role in the Aggie Players' first production of the year, "The Little Foxes." Lillian Hellman's award winning Broadway production.

Mrs. Edwardson, who is perhaps better known as Betty Jo Cook, will be cast as Regina Giddens. She is remembered for her flawless performance in the title role of the Aggie Players' production of "Hedda Gabler," which was presented in March.

"The Little Foxes" opens on November 18 in the Assembly Hall and is scheduled for a three-day run.

A tall, brown-haired beauty of striking appearance, Mrs. Edwardson does not rely on her good features alone for her success, for she has the benefit of extensive training and study in speech and radio. And she has had a wide experience in a variety of roles prior to joining the campus theater group.

Mrs. Edwardson was born in Bryan and is a graduate of Stephen F. Austin high school. She attended TSCW where she received BS and BA degrees in speech and radio. After her graduation from college, she continued her studies in New York City. At present she is employed as principal director for radio station WEAW.

When Mrs. Edwardson graduated from TSCW, she left behind an impressive record of accomplishments. She was president of Zeta Phi Eta, national speech society; secretary of the student body; vice president of the National Collegiate Players, an honorary dramatic organization; and she was elected to Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities.

She also participated in many of the dramatic productions at TSCW and played the leading roles in "The Cherry Orchard" and "The Show Off." As mistress of ceremonies for the Madras Chapter of TSCW, she made many appearances performing at army camps and hospitals.

Other roles in "The Little Foxes" include Reginald's son, Ben Hubbard, a cruel and egotistical man who would betray his wife for money and power; George Williams as Oscar Hubbard, who is also power-mad but not as crafty as Ben Hubbard; Scotty Sweeney as Leo Hubbard, the naive and simple son of Oscar; and the role of Miss Giddens, Regina's neglected husband, Alexander Giddens, a J. Fowler as William Marshall; a J. Hester as Addie; and Jack Simmonds as Cal.

Names of the cast were released today by Garvis W. Little, director of the Aggie Players, who said that the production of "The Little Foxes" is rounding into shape nicely.

"The rehearsals have been hard on the cast," Little said, "but they get better every night. When the play opens on November 18, I am certain that we shall have a play no one will want to miss."
