ORDINANCE NO. 124 PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF

PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF ANY DEVICE, MACHINE, APPARATUS OR INSTRUMENT TO INTENSIFY OR AMPLIFY OR REPRODUCE THE HUMAN VOICE OR ANY OTHER SOUND ON ANY PUBLIC STREET OR IN ANY BUILDING WHEREBY THE SOUND THEREFROM IS CAST DIRECTLY UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS IN THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION TO PRESERVE THE QUIET AND GOOD ORDER OF THE CITY AND TO PREVENT THE DISTURBANCE OF PERSONS OWNING, USING, OR OCCUPYING PROPERTY ADJACENT TO THE PUBLIC STREETS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS:

Section 1. That is shall be unlawful for any person to use or operate, or cause to be used or operated, any mechanical or electrical device, machine, apparatus or instrument to intensify or to amplify or to reproduce the human voice, or any other sound, on any public street within the corporate limits of the City of College Station.
