Norman Appointed Warrant Officer

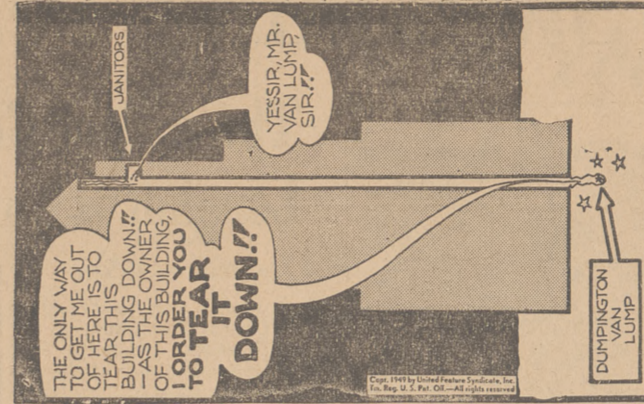
