and of sanitary conditions in general. Items which will be checked in particular are: accumulations of trash and rubbish, unkept wood piles and other rat harbors, overgrown and unkempt vacant lots, and standing pools of stagnant water. Other items which will be of special interest to the inspectors will be means of sewage disposal, house screening, and conditions under which livestock (including fowls) is kept, the committee said. College officials in charge of buildings and grounds will be requested to take special steps to aid in making the campaign a success. Dr. Pitter concluded that now is the time for all residents and business men to take inventory and to make plans to have everything in shape not later than April 9.
