Cytoplasmic factor affecting male sterility in corn will be discussed by John R. Edwardson at the Agronomy seminar in the Experiment Station Building Saturday at 9 a. m.

According to Edwardson, graduate student in Agronomy, male sterility in sugar beets and onions has been used in producing hybrids and he will discuss the possibility in use of male sterility in corn.

The cost of producing hybrid seed corn can be reduced if this male sterile corn plant can be used Edwardson said.
