Adjustments Listed

Under the new provision, the owner of a building containing four or less dwelling units may get an adjustment if his net operating in-come is less than 25 per cent of his gross income. He will be grant-

his gross income. He will be granted an increase to bring his net operating income up to 30 per cent.

An owner of a large structure (five or more dwelling units) is entitled to an adjustment if his net operating income is less than 20 per cent of gross income. The increase will be sufficient to bring the net operating income up to 25 per cent. When granted, the adjustment is effective from the date the petition was filled.

Net operating income, Benning-field said, is the amount of income left after payment of operating ex-

left after payment of operating expenses and an allowance for depreciation. 


