puts the other 3 pages together. When the forms are completed and locked, another proof of each complete page is made and checked for errors. Final corrections are then made and inserted in the form.  
From the composing room, the pages are rolled into the press-room, and the pressmen place the lead forms in two tiers on the press. After adjustments are made the press is set in motion and the Batt is "off."  
One of the editors takes one of the first few papers off the press and checks it once again for errors. If one is found, the presses must be stopped, the forms removed, the correction set on the linotype and inserted in the form before the printing process can get underway again.  
As the paper rolls off the press, the Circulation Department takes charge, and distribution is made to dorms and campus offices. It's all over now, and you've got your Batt and reading that story we traced from the beginning. But even while you are reading that story, the staff has already been working for three or four hours on the next edition.  
The "magic" of putting out a newspaper is, after all, just work, a lot of it and nothing more.
