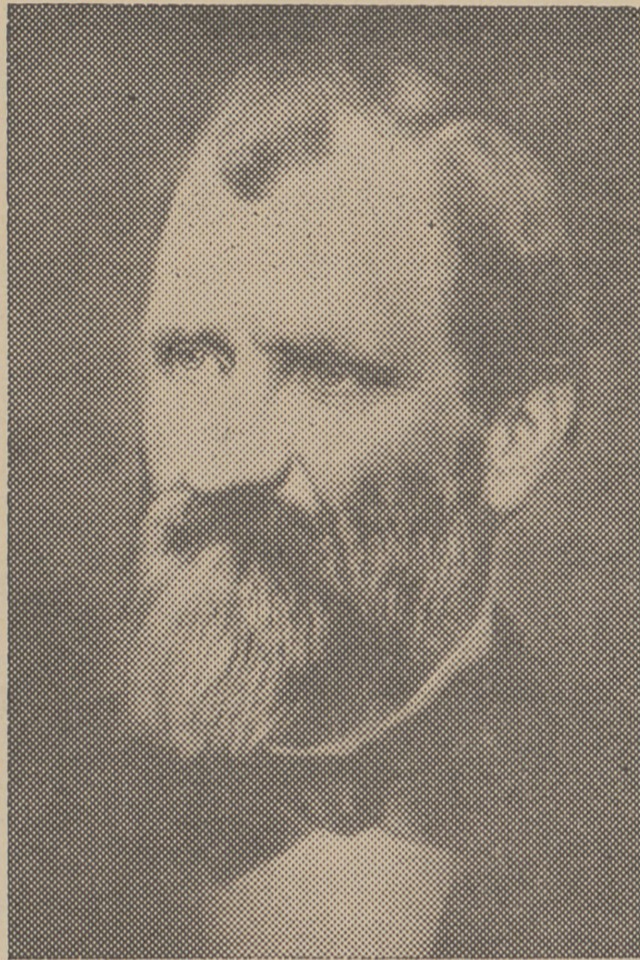


Past Presidents of Texas A&M

And the names of most of them have been ingrained into the soul of Aggie-land. Three, especially, rank as outstanding—Lawrence Sullivan Ross, “Founder of Aggie Traditions;” Gibb Gilchrist, present Chancellor of the A&M System; and Frank C. Bolton, 41-year faculty member and present President Emeritus.

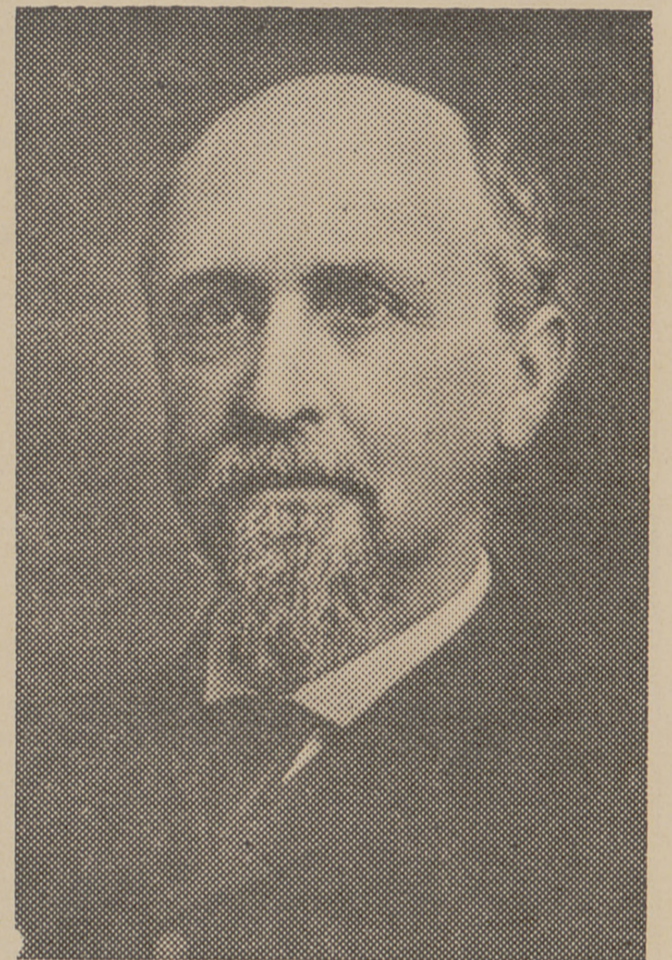

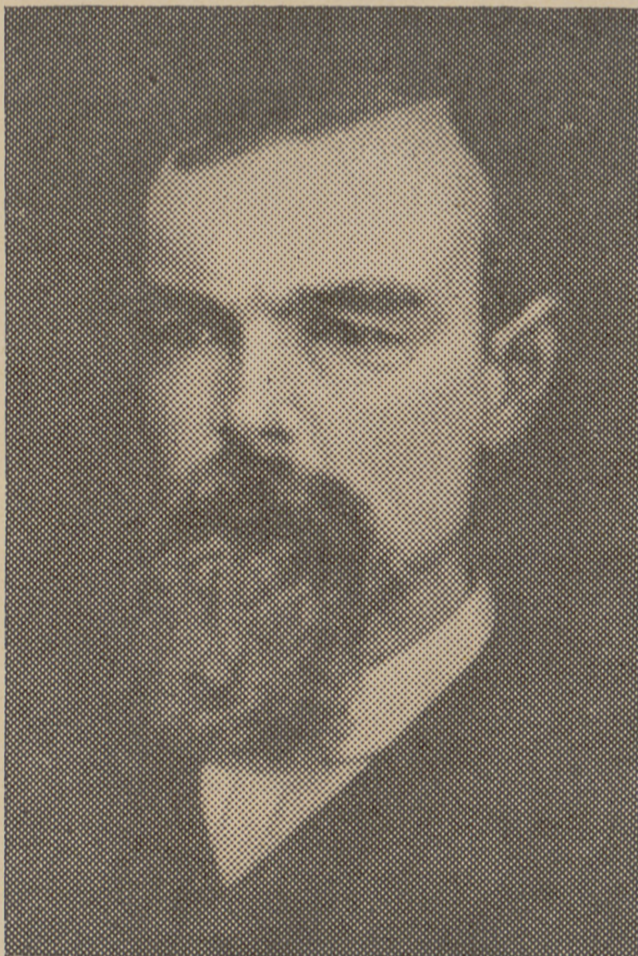

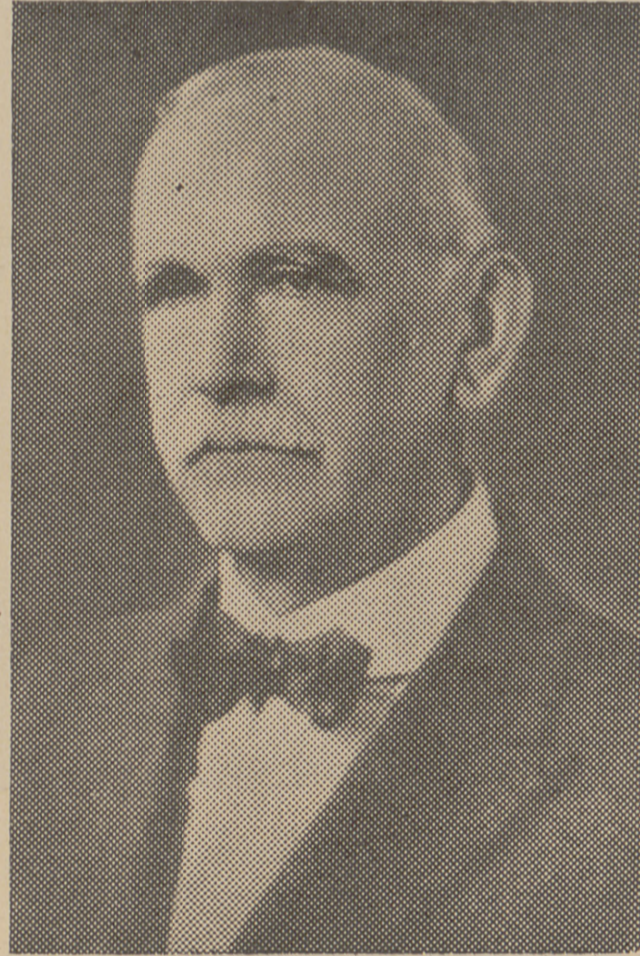
