A promising field has opened for electrical engineering majors who are interested in the phase of rural electrification, according to the Rural Electrification Administration.

Engineers who have been qualified in any of the several branches of the electrical utility industry are being sought by REA. Distribution, transmission, or generation experience, whether in construction or operation, can serve as a qualification.

The starting salaries of the electrical positions now open with REA are \$4,600 and \$5,400 a year, depending upon training and experience.

## A&M Prof Attends Oak Ridge Seminar

Frank L. Thomas Jr., instructor in the Electrical Engineering Department, is attending a Research Seminar at Oak Ridge, Tennessee. He will be there until Dec. 16.

Mr. Thomas, a lieutenant in the U. S. Naval Reserve, is attached to the Volunteer Research Unit 8-3 at College Station. He is one of 50 research officers attending the seminar.

The seminar is being conducted under the sponsorship of the Office of Naval Research. In general, the seminar consists of lectures by heads of department at Oak Ridge and officers from the bureaus of the Navy Department and inspection of the activities at Oak Ridge.
