were the finest club in the National League as they racked up one TD in the second quarter on the crack shot passing arm of Tommy Thompson, and added seven more points in the third on a blocked punt.

The owners and the players wanted to postpone the game until Christmas Day, and so did thousands of protesting fans. But Commissioner Bert Bell, in Philadelphia, forced the contest—the seventh National League title play-off—to go on.

Soil Conservation Classes End Trip

The soil conservation class under the instruction of J. F. Mills made an all day field trip to Temple, Saturday, to see soil conservation practices carried out on the Blackland Experiment Station and farms of that district.

The group's first stop was at Rosebud where Thomas Elder, work unit conservationalist of the Rosebud Soil Conservation District, explained how farmers were using K-R Bluestem in constructing terrace outlets.

That afternoon the group visited the Temple agricultural experiment sub-station.

According to Mills, the purpose of the trip was to familiarize students with soil and water conservation methods being carried out in that district and the research work at the Blackland Experiment Station.

EE Prof Speaker At AIEE Meeting

L. M. Haupt, professor of electrical engineering, Texas Engineering Experiment Station, A&M, was one of the principal speakers at the meeting of the South Texas Subsection of the American Institute of Electrical Engineers held in Corpus Christi Wednesday night.

Professor Haupt presented a paper on "The Modern Network Calculator Use in System Planning and Research." He discussed the work that is being done on the A&M network calculator for the electric utility companies and the progress that is being made in adapting the calculator to problems other than electrical.

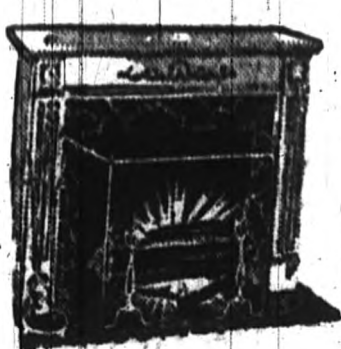
