

Civil Service Positions Open

The United States Civil Service Commission has announced an examination for Supply Specialists for filling positions in the fields of general supply, store-keeping and storage, property and stock control, requirements and distribution, surplus property disposal, printing and publications, and supply cataloging.

The positions are located in Washington, D. C., and vicinity. Salaries range from \$3,100 to \$6,400 a year.

To qualify, applicants must have had from 3 to 6 years of experience in the field of supply work for

which they apply. The amount and quality of the experience varies with the grade of position. Appropriate education may be substituted for part of the experience. No written test is required. The age limits, 18 to 62 years, are waived for persons entitled to veteran preference.

Further information and application forms, may be secured from the Commission's local secretary, Roger W. Jackson, at the College Station Post Office, from civil service regional offices, or from the U. S. Civil Service Commission in Washington, D. C.
