Big Profits From Exchange Store Birdwell's Efforts Provide Funds for Student Activities

By BILL MEBANE In the past four years \$250,000 of Exchange Store profits have flowed into student recreational channels. This money has been possible through student patronage and through the work of Carl Birdwell, manager of the Exchange Store.

Birdwell has been working in college book stores for 24 years. He graduated from John Tarleton in 1922, taught high school math classes for three years and then took over management of the college book store at John Tarleton in 1926.

The idea came to him that the book store profits could be used for this purpose. Through approval of the school a portion of the profits began to be set aside for student activities.

In April of 1945 Gibb Gilchrist, chancellor of the A&M System, asked Birdwell to come down and take over the store here since the old manager was retiring.
