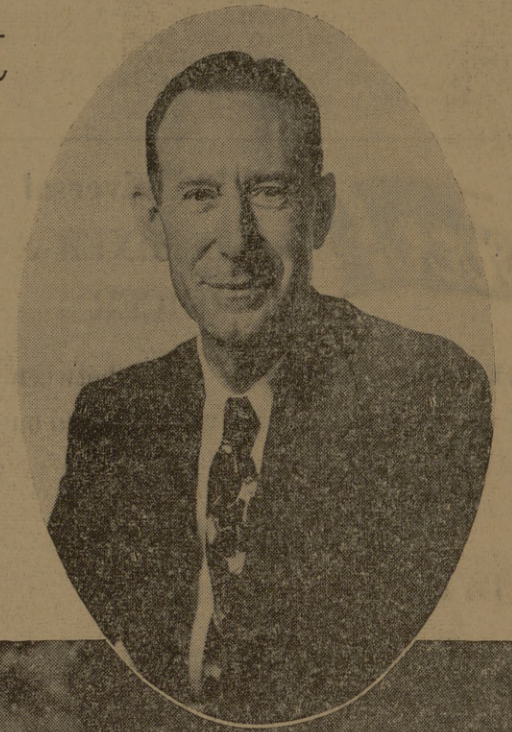

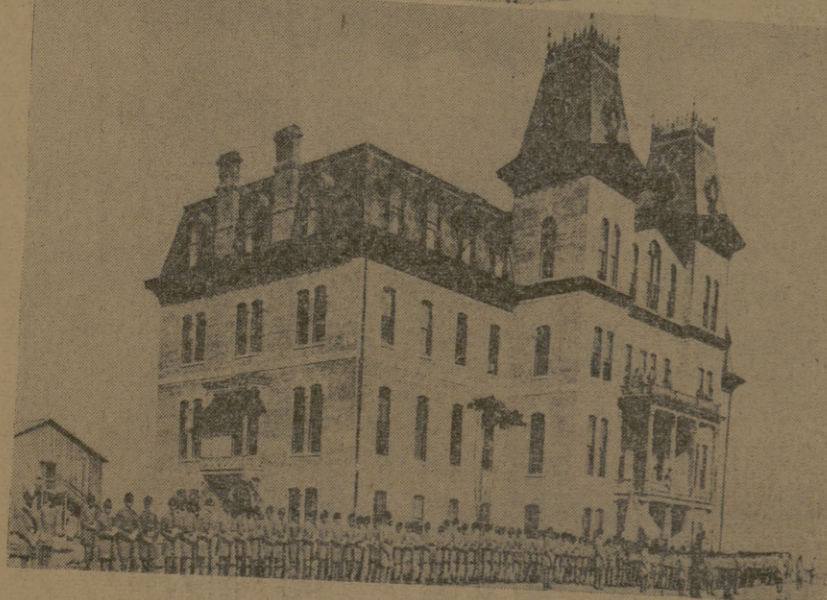
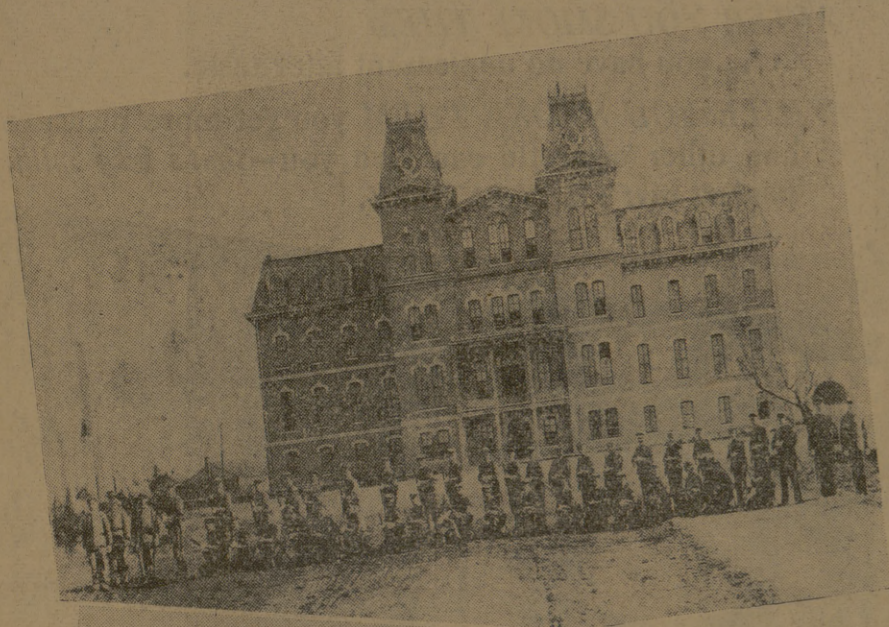

TODAY . . . A Pictorial View Showing The Magnificent A. and M. Main Building And Adjoining Edifices



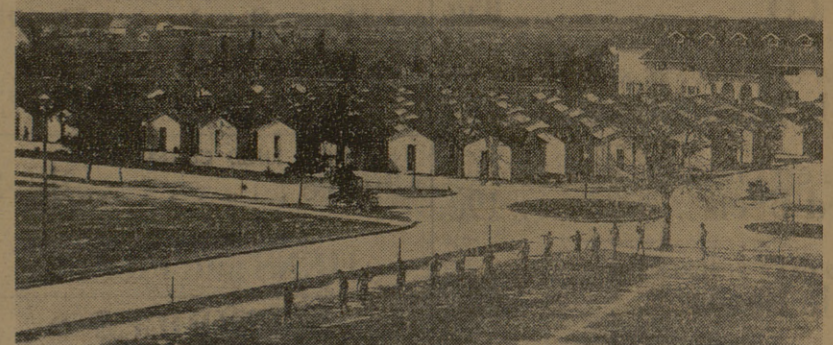
1875 . . . Views of the A. and M. of Seventy-Five Years Ago.
