

The application will be self-addressed and will require a one-cent stamp. On the application form you will be given the choice of where you would prefer to take the test on each of the three dates. You may not choose the date on which you will take the test.

During the first test day, Saturday, May 26, most presently enrolled students concerned by the test will be at College Station taking final exams or studying for finals. Since the test will be given at A&M, you should probably mainting final exams or studying for finals.
