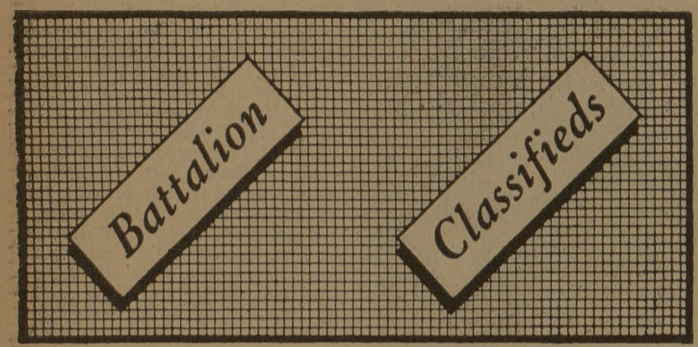


## MSC Schedules Summer Dance
