

Leighton And Klipple Will Lead Consolidated

All-district Jerry Leighton and Gayle Klipple lead the Tiger pack on the Consolidated field tonight at 8 to try their hand at bucking the powerful line of Cypress-Fairbanks High School.

The offensive lineup of Coach O. V. Chafin's gradsters will be the eleven to keep an eye on.

Fred Anderson is slated to do the quarterbacking for Consolidated with Leighton at right half, Klipple at full, and William Arnold rounding out the scrappy little backfield at left half.

Leighton and Klipple stand as seniors while Anderson and Arnold start their grid experience this year as sophomores.

The light but hustling line is built around sophomore center Pinky Cooner. At Cooner's left in the guard slot will be Don Royder, a senior. Right Guard will be Jimmy Bond, another sophomore. Tackles are Thomas Wade, senior, and Dan Williams, sophomore. At left end will be George Johnston, senior, while right end will be David Bommen, sophomore.

Consolidated's defensive line stands as their one sore weak-spot, but hope lies in the improvements which have been made during week's workouts.

A look at the weight of the offensive and defensive teams shows that the first averages up at 135 pounds and the second at a heavier 155.

"I've got a lot of sophomores, in fact almost the entire team, and I'm very pleased with their hustle and they do show that they are good men to develop," said Coach Chafin.

"We'll win games this year and do a lot better than I expected," he continued, "for every man on this team is a part of the team and each one shows his desire in everyday practice to win games."

Chafin's defensive team will be the weakspot but with a minimum of injuries, the Tigers should close the season with a 7 win and 3 loss record. However with more improvement on that weak link, this average should be even better.
