Critical Decision

The decision which the President makes will be watched closely by those critics, in Congress and elsewhere, who have said the automobile industry and especially General Motors will have too large a voice in the making of policy. The background is this: For three years the Bureau of Labor Statistics has been planning for a new cost of living index designed to measure American spending habits on a more up-to-date basis. It is now ready for publication late next month, in place of the old index.

But more than 3 million workers have labor contracts which tie their wages to the cost of living. And the index which their contracts specify shall be used to make these measurements is the old one. Thus, all these contracts will have to be rewritten and fit-

ted to the new index.




